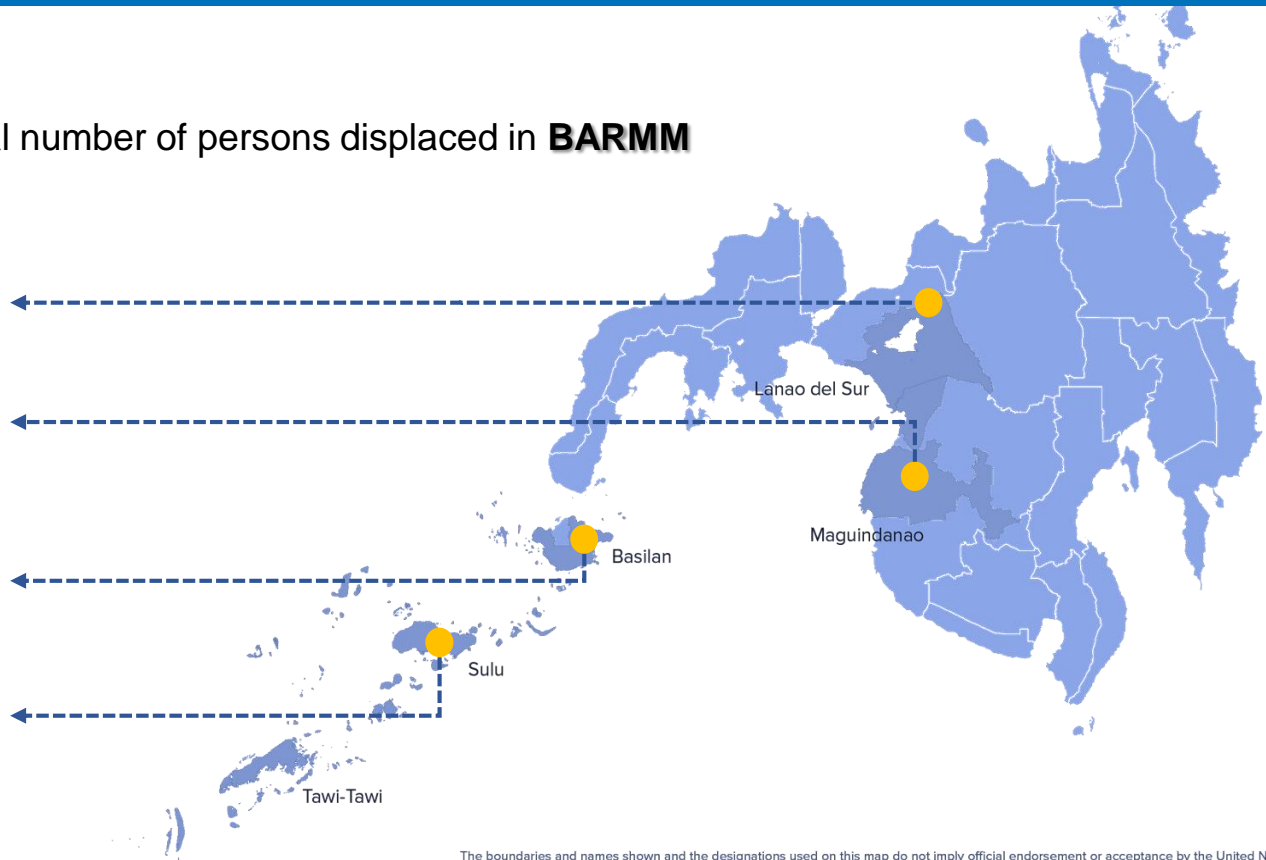

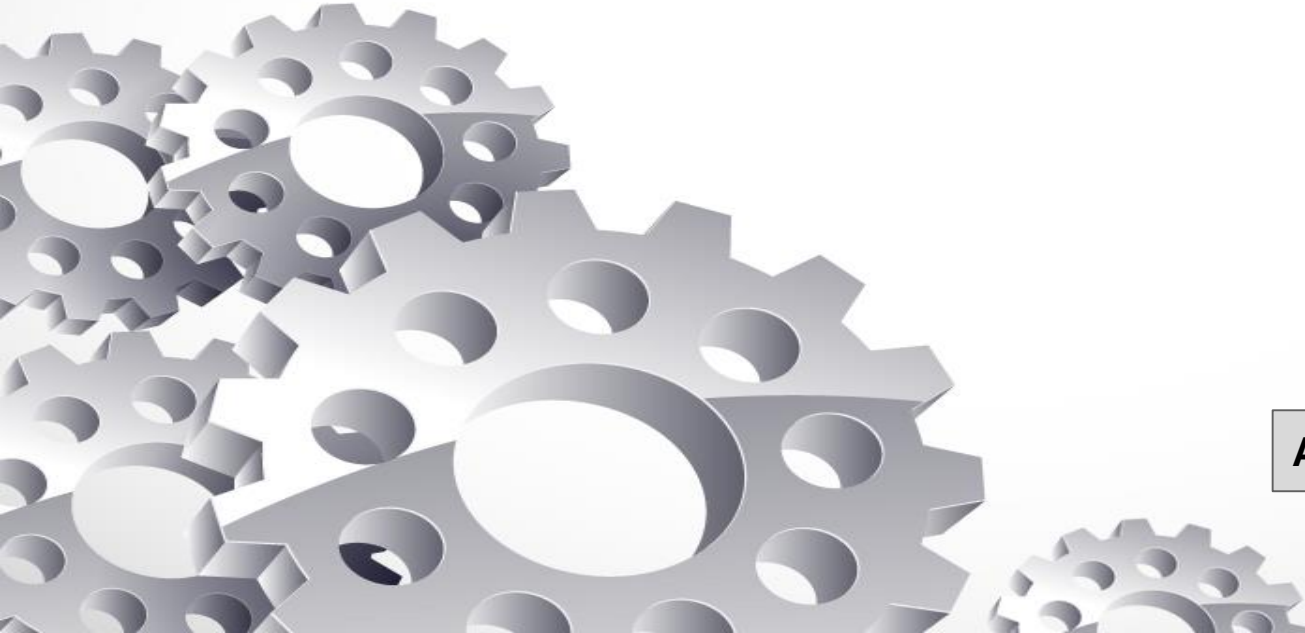

Maguindanao Province

Status Report on Disaster



As of December 15, 2020

Status of Disaster/Emergency in Maguindanao:

The province of Maguindanao had encountered series of arm conflict incidences wherein there were casualties and displaced families who forced to seek refuge to different evacuation sites. Their livelihood activities were hampered and that exacerbated their situation during this COVID 19 Pandemic.

- **November 29, 2020:** Military operations started at Sitio Legao, Angkayamat, SSB, Maguindanao that resulted to the displacement of 200 families to brgy. Langgapanan, SSB. There were allegedly six (6) fishermen hoarded but released immediately by the AFP. Currently there are 20 IDP families who are staying at Langgapanan Elementary School. 180 were staying at their relatives in the said barangay. Because of the on-ing military operation the IDPs dont feel safe to return back to their homes.
- **December 2, 2020, 9:00am:** Firefight between **AFP and unidentified arm group** arose at **Sitio Manguda, Brgy. Itaw, South Upi, Maguidnanao**. Over 300 families evacuated at Multi purpose building at Pob. Itaw and Sitio Luay, Brgy. Itaw. There were also 52 housebased in Sitio Two Lovers, Brgy. Itaw, South Upi.
- **December 3, 2020, 9:20 pm:** Harrassment Incidence. **More or less 100 BIFF members** allegedly led by a certain Sala and Kagi Karialan attacked **Brgy.Poblacion and Brgy Kaguan, Datu Piang, Maguindanao**. The said group came from different directions in attacking the said 2 barangays. The St. Therisita Parish Church was one of the alleged target to burn did not succeed dur to the resistance of the PNP and AFP Personnel. No casualties reported during the attack that lasted until 1:00 am on December 4, 2020. The police car which is 50 meters away from the church was burned by the said group. There were 6 families evacuated at JICA building in Poblacion but returned to their homes in 6:00am of Dec. 4, 2020. No casualties reported.

Status of Disaster/Emergency in Maguindanao:

- **December 7, 2020:** the security operation of the AFP in pursuit of BIFF elements responsible for the attack in the municipality of Datu Piang last December 3, 2020 had caused continuous skirmishes between the two opposing forces in Brgy. Penditen, Datu Salibo and this resulted to the displacement of residents of the adjacent barangays to include **barangay Inaladan, Pusao and Datu Bakal of Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao**. Over **600 families were fled** away from their houses and evacuated from interior sitios to sitio proper/poblacion of the said 3 barangays.
- **December 7, 2020:** Same with SSM, the adjacent municipality-Mamasapano experienced same situation. Due to the security operation of the AFP in pursuit of BIFF members, they allegedly conducting **Nightly Mortar/ Artillery Shelling and Military operations** that frightened the residence of the **interior sitios of brgy. Dabenayan and Brgy. Liab, Mamasapano**. Over **300 families** fled away from their homes and evacuated at **Madrasah Vicinity of Brgy. Liab, and SZOPAD building of Brgy. Dabenayan**. No relief goods were distributed yet. The IDP families leave their homes at night and return to their places of origin at daytime.
- **December 7, 2020-** there were tensions/ firefight incidence between two warring families in **Brgy. Lamud, South Upi**. More or less **115 families** evacuated at **Brgy. Biarong, South Upi**. MSWO and MDRRMO are on-going with their validation and assessment. Same incidence, there were also **121 IDP families** from brgy. Lamud, South Upi who evacuated at **Brgy. Nangi and Boronggotan, North Upi**.

Status of Disaster/Emergency in Maguindanao:

- **December 9, 2020-** Another military operation in pursuit of BIFF members had caused displacement of **122 families of Sitio Pamibingan of Brgy. Tuayan Mother, Datu Hoffer** and evacuated at **Sitio Proper Mother Tuayan ES, Housing Project and Datu Aliman Elementary School**. MLGU and MSSD-Maguindanao already distributed relief goods.
- **December 9, 2020-** the evacuation site in Brgy. North Binangga, Talayan returned to their homes at Brgy. Muslim, Guindulungan and Upper Katibpuan Talayan.
- **December 12, 2020-** The evacuation site at Brgy. Sampao, Guindulungan was closed because IDPs were already returned home at Brgy. Muslim, Guindulungan.
- **December 13, 2020, 7:40 pm-** Mortar shelling happened in Brgy. Sambolawan, Datu Salibo that injured six (6) civilians. 2 children (boy and girl) and 4 adults (all men). > No displacement reported.
- **December 14, 2020:** fire encounter between AFP and BIFF member at Brgy. Indatuan, Northern Kabuntalan at exactly 4:30 AM. No casualties and displacement reported.

Basilan Province

DISPLACEMENT OVERVIEW IN **BASILAN PROVINCE**

- No new displacement was reported but 2,205 individuals remain displaced in Basilan as of the reporting.
- COVID-19 Update. As of 9 December 2020, there are 386 total confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Basilan Province. Of the total number, there are **356 recoveries**, **12 deaths** and **18 active cases**. There are 134 suspect cases. *(This includes data of Isabela City)*

Sulu Province

DISPLACEMENT OVERVIEW IN SULU PROVINCE

- New displacement: 40 families from Siasi Municipality were displaced last 23 November 2020 due to family dispute but the displaced families have returned home after the tension was pacified.

DISPLACEMENT OVERVIEW IN **SULU PROVINCE**

Balik Barangay Program

- 209 IDP families (1,463 individuals) have returned to Brgy. Maligay last 5 November 2020
- 224 families (1,484 individuals) have returned to Brgy. Kabbun Takas last 20 November 2020
- Needs of the returning IDPs include shelter materials. LGU is sourcing for donations from other agencies.

Balik Barangay Program (services provided to the returning IDPs)

MLGU Patikul

- 300 pcs galvanized roof
- 209 sacks of rice
- Toys for the children

PLGU Sulu

- 500 pcs galvanized roof
- 300 sacks of rice
- Feeding conducted every Sunday

Balik Barangay Program (services provided to the returning IDPs)

MSSD-Sulu

- Food packs (25 kls. of rice, 7 packs of noodles, 5 tins of sardines)
- Blue water galoon and 1 pc. blanket
- Supplemental feeding to 30 identified ECD children
- 286 members of Pantawid Program

Members of the Provincial Council

- Hygiene kits (slipper, face mask, toothpaste and toothbrush)

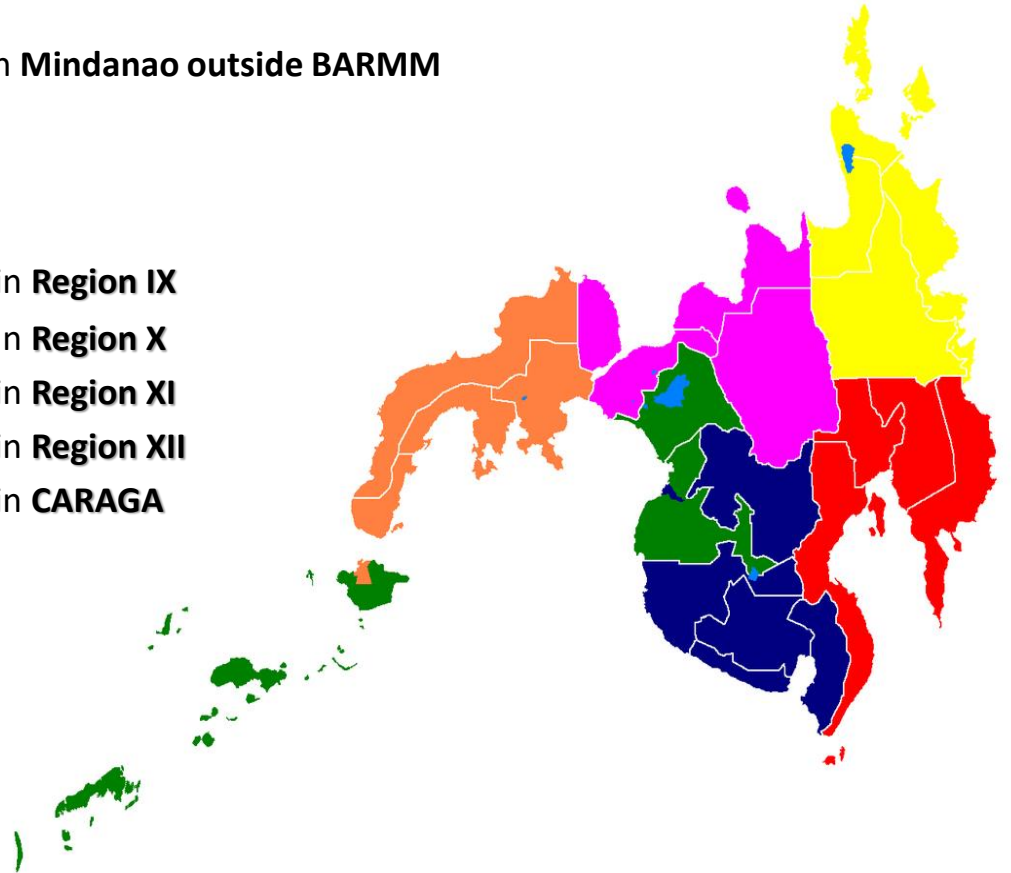
