





Displacement Incident

- On 23 April 2021, an armed encounter ensued between the AFP and ASG in the boundaries of Brgy. Panglayahan and Brgy. Taung in Patikul Municipality that resulted to 3 civilian casualties (1 killed and 2 injured).
- There were 22 families (approximately 86 individuals) forcibly displaced and have temporarily stayed in Taup Elementary School in Barangay Taung, Patikul Municipality
- All displaced families from Barangay Panglayahan have already returned home.

Assistance and Services Provided

- MLGU of Patikul provided food packs consist of canned goods, noodles and rice.
- BLGU of Taung provided security personnel (BPAT) stationed at the evacuation center
- AFP provided supplemental feeding for the IDP children

Lanao del Sur

Whirlwind Occurrence

Brgy. Guimba, Marawi City

- 43 families affected of the strong whirlwind last May 2, 2021
- 17 houses totally damaged
- Estimated 17 families are temporarily in refuge with their relatives within Brgy. Guimba
- Affected families are in need of shelter assistance to rebuild and/or repair the damages
- Barangay and City LGU provided food packs to the affected families

Marawi Displacement

(Protection Issues/Needs of IDPs at the Transitory Sites)

- **Food security and Livelihood:** Diminishing food supply. Last distribution of BARMM was March 2021 Lack of permanent livelihood unable the displaced families to meet their basic needs including food, personal hygiene materials, for education
- **WASH:** Insufficient water rations (Boganga and Sagonsongan). Foul smell from the septic tanks as many are directly connected to the drainage canal (Sagonsongan Areas). Desludging in Boganga continues. Clogged drainage canal due to solid waste are prevailing in Boganga and Sagonsongan.
- **Access to basic services due to distance.** High transportation cost which limit the IDPs to access the market, health office, hospital, schools. E-trike of the LGU is on schedule basis.

EMERGCENY/DISASTER UPDATES IN MAGUINDANAO PROVINCE

As of May 3, 2021

The Background:

- March 18, 2021- mortal shelling and encounter between AFP and BIFF at Brgy. Kitango and Pusao which resulted to massive displacement of over (13,000 families) of the said barangays and nearby barangays.
- April 10-16, 2021- massive return of about 10,000 IDP families to their places of origins.
- April 23, 2021- another mortal shelling targeting Brgy. Inaladan, SSM that resulted to the displacement of 882 families in three evacuation centers in Brgy. Ganta and sitio Patawali of Inaladan, SSM. Brgy. Penditen and Brgy. Pandi of Datu Salibo were also affected with this mortal shelling, 589 families sought to refuge at Brgy. Hall and Day Care Center of Brgy. Penditen.
- April 26, 2021- The AFP launched a mortal shelling targeting the marsh area of the municipality of Talitay and brgy. Tugal of Datu Anggal Midtimbang. The IDP families are now staying in Pageda Evacuation Center in Talitay. There was accordingly a house which was hit by mortal shelling in Datu Piang but upon validation it was a light material comfort room. No casualties reported.
- April 28, 2021 at around 9:05 in the morning, another mortal shelling hit Sitio Bayog, Dapiawan and Sitio Tatapan of Barangay Kitango, DSA that caused the death of 2 civilian and 2 injured civilians. The tensions escalated which resulted to another massive displacement. The number of IDP families reported as of April 28, 2021 is 3,990 but expected to increase as there were continuously moving out on their places of origins.




- **Food is the primary need.** MSSD, PDRRM and MLGUs are continuously providing food packs especially to those newly opened and reactivated ECs.
- **Psychosocial Support for Women and Children.** Due to the repeatable displacement, IDPs need psychosocial support especially those bereaved families of casualties.
- **Livelihood Support** for especially for female headed families.
- **Emergency Shelter** (recommended: Modular tents for indoor ECs or re-useable tents for outdoors Ecs).
- **Non-food items for the newly existing IDPs.** (recommend to include slippers on the content).
- **Strengthen Legal Support for the minors (CICL)** who are caught handling illegal firearms (suspected to be involved in armed groups).
- Strengthen **Camp Coordination and Camp Management**
- Long Term Plan: **Establishment of Evacuation Centers in SPMS Box.**
